SUBMIT TO COMMITTEE ON CONSTITUTION, BYLAWS, AND RULES

The Constitution, Article V, Sections 2(a) and 3(b), vests documentation of timely submission of an amendment in the contact persons for the amendment. Amendments to the Constitution must be submitted to the Committee on Constitution, Bylaws, and Rules by the end of the 7th business meeting. Amendments to the Bylaws must be submitted to the Committee on Constitution, Bylaws, and Rules postmarked no later than one hundred and twenty (120) days prior to the Annual Meeting. Such amendments should be mailed by certified mail to the Executive Office of the National Education Association, 1201 Sixteenth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20036, and the contact person should retain a copy of all materials so submitted.
